OUR SOCIAL ACTION PROJECT THIS YEAR IS:



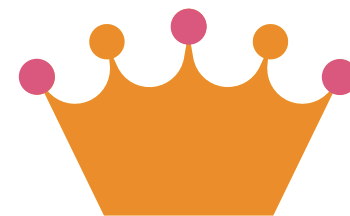
